### **PARKS & REC UPDATE**

Community Center Accessibility Upgrades

The Parks and Recreation Department is excited to have so much going on to improve our patron experience. There is a new automatic door into the Wayne Owens Gymnasium to make it easier for all to access, and we anticipate the new ramp to the office and gym level to be completed by Festival Weekend. The ramp to the tennis court will be completed at the same time. We will be closing the pool August 25 so construction on the pool deck can commence for the new Bubble anchoring system. We anticipate roughly 8 weeks of closure at the pool before we reopen with the new Bubble installed, and any members with active aquatics memberships will have their membership paused so they aren't paying for a closed amenity. We will also be undergoing some work in the bowling alley at this time, and Tiger Gym will have guttering installed, as well as painting completed in the lobby and restrooms and a new lobby floor will be installed. We are also working on stream and playground solutions for Children's Park, and McGalliard Falls Park will have some small updates, as well. This project is funded largely through a NC State Parks Accessibility in Parks grant.
